## Sabbath Day Devotion

### Working Together –

Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their work. If one falls down, his friend can help him up. But pity the man who falls and has no one to help him up. (Ecclesiastes 4:9-10)

In rural America, we often admire and look up to those who appear to be ultra-independent and self-reliant. They seem to have it all together. They appear to be able to get along just fine without anyone else's help or assistance.

The older and wiser I become, however, the more I realize that happy and successful lives are built on relationships with other people. Instead of independence, we should be seeking interdependence. The more friends and relationships people have the more successful, contented and happy they seem to be.

Win-Win... I suggest you work to develop as many win-win relationships as you can. A win-win relationship is one in which all those involved benefit from being involved. It is people helping people. It can never be one-sided. Stephen Covey is quoted as saying, "Win-win sees life as a cooperative arena – not a competitive arena."

Don't Forget... the most important relationship of all is your relationship with the Lord our God through Jesus. If you do not have a personal and saving relationship with God, then all that you have is temporary at best.

The Church is NOT a building or a denomination. The church is made up of people who have a relationship with the Lord our God – as well as with one another. There is no such thing as a lone-ranger Christian or a one-person church.
