You may not know me, but I know everything about you. Psalm 139:1

Shame caused Adam and Eve to run from the presence of their all knowing, all seeing Father. But God does not want us to run from Him, but rather run to Him.

Even when we do hide, we can't escape His loving gaze. Yes our Father knows us intimately and He loves us with an everlasting love. The love that we are familiar with is usually conditional and based upon performance.
