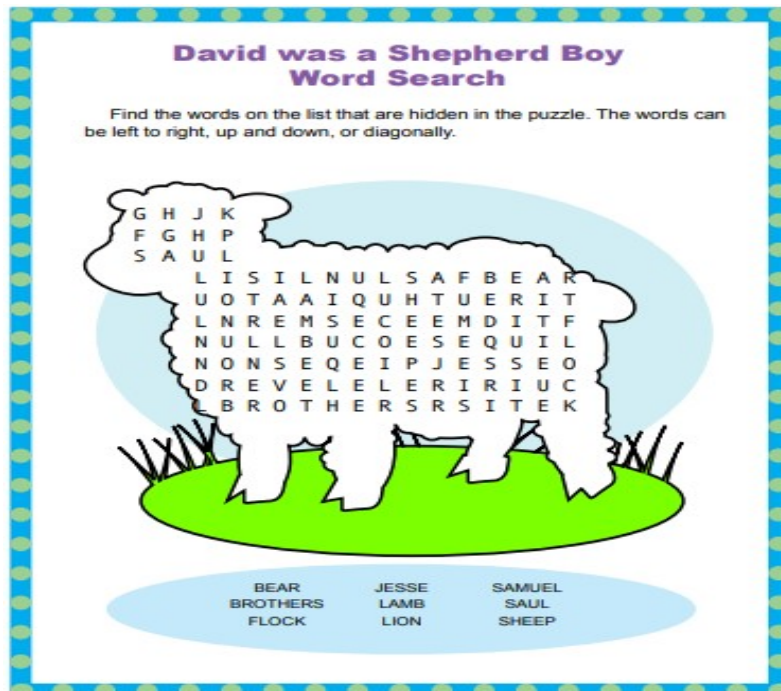

### Devotional #28 of The Father's Love Letter

*I desire to establish you with all my heart and all my soul.*

**I will rejoice in doing them good and will assuredly plant them in this land with all my heart and soul. Jeremiah 32:41 (NIV Bible)**

When Father declared that He loved you, He didn't do it half-hearted. He planted you in His love with ALL His heart and soul. The love that God demonstrates does not go half way, but is fully committed to giving you everything and not holding back anything.
