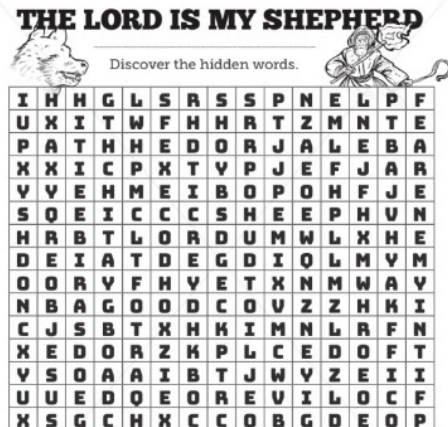

Devotional #29 of The Father's Love Letter

And I want to show you great and marvelous things.

Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know. Jeremiah 33:3(NIV Bible)

When my children were very small, they would be full of questions. "Dad, why is the sky blue? Dad, where do animals go when they die? Dad?" Their probes would go on and on. While I didn't always have the answer to their questions, I never turned them away or forbid them from asking again. In fact, I actually marveled at their inquisitive nature and their desire to learn all about their surroundings.
