Devotional #32 of The Father's Love Letter

Philippians 2:13 (NIV Bible)*

In our previous devotional message, we read about how God promises to give us the desires of our heart if we will just delight in Him (Psalm 37:4) In Philippians, chapter 2 we read that it is God who actually works in us to will and to act according to his good purpose.
