-So Many!

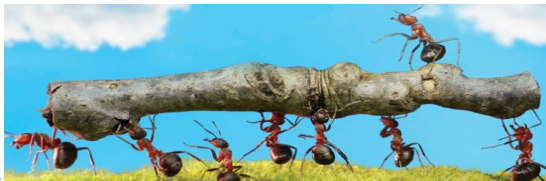
For every person walking around on the earth, there could be as many as 16 million ants!
