The juvenile lookdown sports long filaments from its dorsal fin, which help it blend in with grasses. Light is reflected by guanine pigments in the lookdown's skin so that it flashes like a silver mirror.



The lookdown is a shimmery, silvery fish with an extremely blunt forehead.

Its body is also extremely compressed.

This fish gets its name from the way it appears to look down its nose, like a snobbish person.

This fish is sometimes known as the threadfin lookdown. Another name for the lookdown is the bluntnose. This name comes from its unusual shape.

The lookdown is a summer and fall visitor to inshore areas from Maine to the Carolinas, as it prefers waters over 60°F (15°C).

Why Do I Do It?

Has anyone ever asked you why you share God's Word with others? If not, perhaps it is because you are not sharing God's Word with others.

"Unlike so many, we do not peddle the word of God for profit." 2 Corinthians 2:17

That is all the incentive I need to share God's Word and the Gospel of Christ with all of the people within my circle of influence.
