Beetles That See in 3D

Seeing the amazing design of the jewel scarab beetle is like looking at a sign that reads, "Made By God!"

Watching a movie in 3D isn't very enjoyable without 3D glasses. We need the glasses to see a special kind of light called circular polarization, or CP. Human eyes cannot detect this type of light without help.

Did you know that there is a special kind of beetle that can actually see CP light? God not only designed the jewel scarab beetle, *Chrysina gloriosa*, with eyes that can see CP light; but He also gave these beetles the ability to reflect CP light off their bodies. Scientists think that jewel scarab beetles might use their special abilities to communicate with each other and to hide from predators. *

When we look at the workmanship in an intricately carved piece of wood, or the technology behind a DVD player, we know that someone created these items. Seeing the amazing design of the jewel scarab beetle is like looking at a sign that reads, "Made By God!"

Imagine going back two hundred years in time and trying to describe a Jumbo Jet. You say, "Where I come from, we have these huge tin cans, weighing hundreds of tons that float across the sky filled with hundreds of people." Someone says, "Do you think we are stupid? That's impossible. There is such a thing as gravity. Not even a feather can float across the sky unaided, without descending."

However, we now have discovered that when an object of a particular shape travels at a certain speed, it moves out of the influence of gravity into a higher law, the law of aerodynamics. Gravity remains, but the object supersedes it.

We have also discovered that when a person becomes a Christian, he moves out of one law into another. The law of life in Christ Jesus supersedes what the Bible calls "the law of sin and death." The Christian lives in a higher plane: "For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death" (Romans 8:2)
