Noah Trusted God

4,300 years ago Noah spent many years building the Ark. He may have hired people to help him and used lots of sophisticated machinery to build it. When it was finished, Noah and his family (his wife, three sons, and three daughters-in-law) stocked the Ark with food and water for themselves and the animals, gathered their belongings, and entered the Ark. God brought the animals, and Noah worked to get the thousands of animals settled and ready for the voyage.

A few days later, the ground rumbled as the fountains of the great deep started to break up, pushing hot lava onto the ocean floor and causing the sea level to rise. And it began to rain . . . a lot (GENESIS 7:11-12). Soon the ground around the Ark was covered with water, and the Ark began to float in the Flood that God had said He would send.

Sadly, every person who wasn't on the Ark died in the Flood. Only Noah and his family (and the animals) were safe in the Ark. Only Noah, with God's help, had trusted God to provide a way (the Ark) for him to be saved from the watery judgment that covered the whole earth.

Has America Forgotten God?

In continuing the Thanksgiving Day thoughts I shared in this week's PCC Update, I would like to share a quote from Abraham Lincoln. On April 30, 1863, in a proclamation for a national day of fasting and prayer, Lincoln wrote:

"We have been the recipients of the choicest bounties of heaven. We have been preserved, these many years, in peace and prosperity. We have grown in numbers, wealth and power, as no other nation has ever grown. But we have forgotten God. We have forgotten the gracious hand which preserved us in peace, and multiplied and enriched and strengthened us; and we have vainly imagined, in the deceitfulness of our hearts, that all these blessings were produced by some superior wisdom and virtue of our own. Intoxicated with unbroken success, we have become too self-sufficient to feel the necessity of redeeming and preserving grace, too proud to pray to the God that made us! It behooves us, then, to humble ourselves before the offended Power, to confess our

national sins, and to pray for clemency and forgiveness."

If Lincoln's statements were true in 1863, they are even more true today. America and Americans have forgotten God. We have truly become intoxicated with our unbroken success. We have become too self-sufficient to feel the need to recognize and acknowledge God, our creator. In 2 Chronicles 7:14, God says: "If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land."

God Bless America! There is no doubt God has truly blessed America in many, many ways. One has to wonder, though, how long will God continue to bless America if America does not bless or acknowledge God? I am afraid America and Americans are walking on thin ice. Don't just GO to church; BE the church
