### The Law of Launching

If you have not seen in person or on video, the launching of a ship, I beg you to take a few minutes and check Youtube. You can find compilations of these things. After months or years of building a new ship or repairing an existing ship, the ship is prepared to be launched. Much preparation and planning has gone into constructing the ship. It is specifically designed to withstand the forces it will experience, carry the load it is made for and endure the test of time. The launch is prepared and all is ready. The ship looks beautiful and peaceful. Everything appears uneventful. Then the trigger is pulled, and it is launched by letting it slide sideways into the water. Now if you were the ship at this moment, this would most likely be a moment of terror. You may or may not be aware of all of the care and design that you ship builder has put into you, but even if you did, it would still be scary. You most likely would think you are going to sink straightaway as you list steeply and dip into the water. But you are designed for this and quickly right yourself.

A launching of any kind is dramatic and a little terrible. It is preceded by planning and preparation, after which the thing is released to that which it is made for. There is a finality about it. The thing cannot return and is released towards its destiny.

This is true of a ship, a rocket, a bullet, an arrow, or even a business or a new product or some other endeavor.

It is also true spiritually. God has created you for a purpose. Maybe you have already experienced a launching. Maybe you are still on the dock. Maybe you were launched, completed an assignment and are back on the dock being prepared for another assignment. Another launch is coming. Don't fight it. Don't rush it. Don't be bothered by the ships that are in the water now and are gliding by with big and impressive loads. Your turn is coming and you are being prepared very intentionally for the task ahead of you. The Ship Builder has a plan. Rest and know that he is the master. Allow him to do the work that he wants to do inside of you. Embrace that which he is building you for. It will be an awesome voyage.
