We are back again to take another look at God's "sticky" creatures Today we'll be looking at Ridges, Clingy hairs, Suckers & Clamps.

Getting Stuck: How God's Creatures Hold On

Ridges Creation: The ridges on your fingertips help you grip even slippery objects like pencils. *Potential Use:* Better surfaces for gripping cellphones and other slippery items.

Clingy Hairs Creation: Beetles have tiny hairs on their feet that cling to surfaces, allowing them to walk upside down. *Potential Use:* Reusable insect tape

Suckers: *Creation:* Octopus arms have suckers that latch onto food and won't let go until they're ready. *Potential Use:* Better suction cups with a stronger grip.

Clamps: *Creation:* Crabs have specialized pincers that grab their grub. *Potential Use:* Tools with better grips.
