Paws

Hi, my name is Paws, and I'm a sea otter. You've probably seen videos of a sea otter like me using tools to crack open a stubborn shell, playing in the cold ocean water, or even cuddling or "holding hands" with another otter. We're pretty popular creatures, probably because God designed us fluffy and cute.

Did you know sea otters are some of the only animals that use tools? Small rocks make a great hammer to chip food off another rock or smash open something yummy. We even roll onto our backs and use our bellies as a table!

To find our food, we can dive 330 ft (100 m) below the water. Special flaps close our ears and noses to keep the cold ocean water out. Unlike many sea mammals, we don't have a layer of blubber to keep us warm, so God designed us with the thickest fur of any mammal, which traps air bubbles so we can stay toasty even in cold water. Here are some fun facts about sea otters:

•We sometimes wrap kelp or seaweed around ourselves when we sleep so we don't drift away. Other times we will gather together in huge groups called "rafts."

- We eat up to 20 pounds (9 kg) of food every day!
- Baby sea otters are born in the water. They can't swim right away, but they have a special kind of fur that works like a life jacket, letting them float around in the water. They spend much of their time resting on their mother's chest.
- We have special kidneys that allow us to drink some seawater, but most of our fresh water comes from the food that we eat.

HIT BY A TRUCK WHILE STANDING ON THE SIDEWALK

3 and 1/2 years ago, I was standing on the sidewalk waiting to cross the street when a pickup came through the intersection trying to turn right. His rate of speed and blood alcohol caused him to go up on the sidewalk and hit me. I am a nurse and have always wanted to be a nurse. I loved my job. The injuries I sustained left me with a paralyzed arm among other injuries. The driver was a young man in his 20's. The full extent of the law would have made him in his 30's when he was released. I do not believe this would have been rehabilitative. I asked the judge to give the minimum sentence with alcohol recovery classes. This young man had been very remorseful and when I reached out to him in a letter trying to understand the circumstances of the accident, he could have ignored my letter, but he called me and apologized again. We have all been young once, and have made mistakes. My forgiveness helped me enormously, and any anger or retribution would not have given me my arm back or my job. Before you react to a situation, think of the consequences of your reaction and remember that the other person is a human being.
